Successful HACCP Hygiene Management Certification at the Mill Aalen Quality Audit (DIN EN ISO 9001) and Environmental Audit (DIN EN ISO 14001) successfully confirmed.

At the beginning of May 2006 a very extensive audit was carried out at Papierfabrik Palm Aalen paper mill. This resulted in the successful renewal of both the Quality Management (DIN EN ISO 9001 : 2000) and the Environmental Audit (DIN EN ISO 14001) standards. In addition, for the first time, the mill qualified for the HACCP food hygiene certificate. In all sectors of the three audits all targets were successfully met.

The HACCP accreditation is new for the Aalen mill and this means both Palm production sites in Aalen and Woerth, which are continuously producing paper for corrugated board for the packaging industry, have qualified for the HACCP standard for food hygiene.

„This is an important award for our mills as our products are increasingly supplied to the food industry and therefore have to comply 100 % with their hygiene requirements“, comments Dr. Wolfgang Palm, CEO of Papierfabrik Palm. For effective hygiene management all partners of the supply chain must conform to HACCP criteria. Consequently, with this accreditation Palm is a leader in this area and anticipates an increasing demand for products from customers in the food sector requiring HACCP accreditation.
